Complete the following steps in your Grofar Careers Passport:

Step 1 – Login to your digital Careers Passport

1. Log into Grofar using your registered email address.

Step 2 – Find the 'Job Roles' & 'Industry Sectors' sections

- 1. Once logged in, scroll down to the bottom of your Home page until you see the sections for 'Job Roles' and 'Industry Sectors.'
- 2. In this activity you will complete these two sections.



Job Role: relates to the job title and description of the job you might do when working for a business e.g. **Software Developer**

Industry Sector: is a term for a group of businesses which are related based on their primary business activities (how they make the majority of their money). e.g. *Manufacturing*



Step 3 – Complete the 'Industry Sectors' section

- 1. Click on the green edit choices button **FDIT CHOICES** next to **'Industry Sectors'**, this will take you to the **'Edit Industry Sectors'** section.
- 2. Tick the boxes of each Industry Sector that you are interested in and you'd like to learn more about in future careers lessons.
- 3. Once you have selected all of the sectors you are interested in, click the **'SAVE'** button.

Step 4 - Complete the 'Job Roles' section

- 1. Make sure you are back on your Home page.
- 2. Scroll down to the section titled 'Job Roles' and click on the green edit choices button CHOICES to go to the 'Edit Job Roles' section.
- 3. In this section you will notice a list of job roles.
 - Each of these roles has a blue information circle **i** which you can select to learn more about the role from the <u>National Careers Website</u>.
 - Explore some job roles to find the ones which interest you most.
- 4. Once you have done some research, tick the box next to the Job Roles you would like to learn more about.
- 5. Once you have finished selecting Job Roles, click the **'SAVE'** button.
